



Young Telecoms Engineer of the Year

Terms and conditions of entry

Eligibility

Entrants must be student members of the Institution of Engineering and Technology (the IET) who are in their final year at university on a qualifying undergraduate degree course. They must be available for work during the summer of 2011 and be able to work in the UK.

Conditions

1. Entry to this competition is free and is open to student members of the IET who are eligible to work in the UK.
2. Only one entry will be accepted from each entrant.
3. Entries must be submitted in the format specified in the entry form.
4. Intellectual Property will be retained by the applicant but MLL Telecom will have the right to reference it in public and media.
5. MLL Telecom accepts no responsibility for late or lost entries owing to problems with the internet, email or otherwise. Proof of sending is not proof of receipt.
6. Closing date is no later than 31st January 2011. Entries received after this date will not be considered.

7. By submitting your entry to MLL Telecom for this competition you:

a. Declare that the entry is your own original work, designed and written by you.

b. Declare that you are not plagiarising or infringing the rights of third parties (which include but are not limited to copyright, trade mark, publicity, personal or proprietary rights) and you agree that MLL Telecom shall not be responsible for the infringement of any third party rights in the entry, that may arise as a result of your actions or omission.

c. Agree to indemnify MLL Telecom against all legal fees, claims and damages and other expenses that may be incurred by you as a result of your breach of the terms and conditions.

8. Results will be announced in mid February 2011, but may be delayed at MLL Telecom's discretion.

9. If required, winners will be expected to take part in post-competition publicity. The winning entry and the names of runners up will be published on MLL Telecom's website.

10. A panel of judges will select the winning entry. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

11. The winner will be given the offer of employment with MLL Telecom, commencing in the summer of 2011. Travel, accommodation and other expenses related to winning the competition are the responsibility of the entrant.

12. The prize must be taken as stated and cannot be deferred. There will be no cash alternatives.

13. If MLL Telecom is unable to contact the winner after making reasonable efforts to do so, or the prize is not taken up within 28 days then that winner's prize will be deemed to have been forfeited and MLL Telecom reserves the right to present the prize to another entrant selected by our judges.

14. Entrants must supply full details as required, and comply with these terms and condition to be eligible for the prize. MLL Telecom accepts no responsibility for ineligible entries or entries made fraudulently.

15. MLL Telecom reserves the right to cancel this competition at any stage if it considers this to be necessary or if circumstances arise that are outside of its control.
